Cycle Races in Summerhill, Co. Meath

Promoted by the Dublin Wheelers Cycling Club (founded 1933).

1. Mick Lally Memorial Race (A+, A1, A2)
2. Ian Gallahar Memorial Race (A3)
3. Willie Marks Memorial Race (A4)

Register for each of the races via CI's online registration facility (opens: 11-Feb)

Registration for all 3 races will be via CyclingIreland's online registration facility. Because of the narrow roads, there will be a limit of 80 competitors in each of the races. Online Registration will open on Mon 11-Feb-2019 and will close when the quota is reached or on 28-Feb – whichever happens first. Registration on the day will only be possible, if we do not fill our quota – and then only on a 'first come, first served' basis up to 80 competitors in each of the events. Race HQ is the [Summerhill Community Centre](#) [Coordinates: [53.479836°N,6.733993°W](#)], Enfield Road {L6212}, Summerhill Co. Meath.

Circuit

The races leave the Summerhill Community Centre **neutralised for 1.4km** turning right **Z1** onto the {L6212} through Summerhill village **Z2** out the Kilcock Road {R158}, turning left at the roundabout **Z3** onto the Dunboyne Road {R156}, pausing at Elliott's Accident Repairs {end of neutralised section}. **Garda assistance would be particularly appreciated during the neutralised section.**

Racing starts at Elliott's Accident Repairs [Coordinates: [53.478674°N, 6.714606°W](#)]. The race then proceeds east along the {R156} direction: Dunboyne. Straight past the Moynalvey GAA Centre (4.5km). After 5.6km turn left at Mullagh Cross Roads **J1** [Coordinates: [53.458612°N,6.635220°W](#)] onto the {R125} direction Culmullin / Dunshaughlin. There is a sharp left-hand-bend shortly after this junction. The circuit continues straight past Culmullin Church (10.0km). After 11.6 km turn left at a "T" junction **J2** [Coordinates: [53.502615°N,6.598141°W](#)] onto the R154 (direction Trim). **Garda assistance would be particularly appreciated at this junction.** Continue straight past the Warrenstown Arms Pub (13.3km). After 15.7km turn left at Grange / Batterjohn [Coordinates: [53.521485°N,6.650425°W](#)] **J3** signed Summerhill 8km, onto the {L2207 / L2210}. Cross the finish line [Coordinates: [53.495496°N,6.684822°W](#)] after 19.7km at the cross-roads beside the "Shanks Mare" pub. Continue on the {L2207 / L2210}. Beware of two sharp right-hand bends. After 22.7km, turn left at Elliott's Accident Repair Centre ("T" junction) **J4** onto the R156 (direction Dunboyne). This is the end / start of the circuit. Repeat a number of times depending on your race (see race schedules below).

Races Schedules

Lap distance 22.7km (14.2 miles). Lap time 34 – 37 mins.
